The IB programme gives students the best possible preparation for studying both at German and at international universities.

### Prep Class for the IB Diploma Programme

The class starting in September will be suitable for students aged 14 to 16 and provides the foundations (particularly English and German language proficiency) for entering the IB DP Programme from grade 11.

All classes will be taught in English language and students non-native in English are supported in their English language proficiency. Non-native German speakers will take first steps into this new language or further develop German language skills.



### The prep class will provide:

- · Full day schooling in English according to the curriculum of the German Gymnasium, Baden-Württemberg.
- Small class sizes with individualized learning.
- · Language proficiency support for English and
- Extracurricular activities including Model United Nations, sports clubs, creative and theater clubs and cultural exchanges.
- Accommodation at the boarding house is available.

#### Fees for the prep class

€ 160 per month for tuition, and an additional supplement of € 690 per month for add-ons, including lunch, afternoon activities, additional language support, and travel costs to an international students' conference to a destination

There are a limited number of scholarships available for the programme.
